January 9th, 2013 is undoubtedly a poignant day for the Scholz-Rubin Family, for it signifies the tenth anniversary of the death of their son and brother, Michael Scholz. For the 10-year anniversary of the tragic automobile accident that took Michael's life too soon, we want to honor his memory.

Born October 27th, 1972, Michael's interest and enjoyment of South Florida began at an early age. The abundance of outside activities and the unique tropical environment brought him 'home' regardless of wherever else he traveled.

As a young man, Michael spent his leisure time enjoying all that South Florida had to offer such as boating, wind surfing, water skiing and canoeing.

Michael discovered his calling when attending Life University School of Chiropractic in Atlanta, GA. Upon returning home he established his own firm, Active Spine Centers. He was surprised and delighted by his success and frequently expressed his gratitude for all he had been given. He wanted to give back to those who had not been so lucky, especially to children.

Although he was taken too soon, at the young age of 30, his legacy is still going strong with the Michael Scholz Memorial Charitable Fund.

Following his untimely accident, Michael's family and friends started the Michael Scholz Memorial Charitable Fund: a charity which raises funds for young people to experience and learn to cherish the environment. To accomplish this goal children spend two weeks free of cost at Michael's Magic Camp where they are able to enjoy art expression, science exploration, character building workshops, exciting physical activities and plenty of fun in the sun. Fundraising continues throughout the year to promote the charity and raise money to carry out its goals.

In the spirit of Michael's passion for the outdoors and love of children, Michael's Magic Camp, a not-for-profit agency, invites 85 children to the beautiful Marjory Stoneman Douglas Biscayne Nature Center each year. There the children enjoy two fun filled weeks in which they learn about our marine ecosystem. The children that are chosen to participate in Michael's Magic camp are from low-income communities and are selected based on financial need. Michael's Magic Camp provides young children who otherwise lack the opportunity to experience South Florida's beauty and to develop a respect and love of nature and all its creatures.

Theodora H. Long is executive director of the Marjory Stoneman Douglas Biscayne Nature Center, an organization dedicated to conservation and situated in Crandon Park along the coastal beaches it seeks to preserve. 
